

Healthy Futures and RSVP

RSVP (Retired and Senior Voulteer Program) is a part of AmeriCorps Seniors which focuses on six areas of critical need in communities. One of these areas is healthy futures, which centers around older adults being able to age comfortably in their homes and on those individuals of any age in the community that are at-risk and/or are food insecure. Meals on Wheels/RSVP volunteers serve in the following Healthy Futures areas across our five counties.

All Meals on Wheels RSVP volunteers are dedicated to the mission of serving nutritionally at-risk older adults a hot meal daily, Monday through Friday, and for the most disadvantaged on the weekends. We also have volunteers in Tallapoosa County that deliver Meals on Wheels through the Russell Hospital and RSVP volunteers serve in a Mobile Meals program in Newsite. 18 seniors receive a daily meal from The General Restaurant. Only two of the original 24 (18 are RSVP) volunteers have dropped out since the program began in 2009.

The senior centers in our five counties provide congregate meals, which are meals served to the seniors who attend the centers and participate in daily activities. Senior centers also provide homebound meals to other older adults who are members of the center but are not able to attend every day. Many of the homebound meals that are delivered are done by RSVP volunteers.

The Millbrook Senior Center is one such center. Olivia Venable is the center manager and works closely with the seniors and the volunteers. About 35-40 seniors come every day for congregate meals and activities. 40 home bound meals are prepared and

delivered daily, and that is where RSVP volunteer Carol

Ann Steward comes in. She faithfully delivers these meals to food insecure seniors. These hot meals allow the people at home to benefit from the good meal and visits from volunteers.

RSVP volunteers say they are motivated to help people in need because through service they become better people themselves.






1st Annual Meals On Wheels Pet Food Drive
